


## 1. ADD PATHBRITE APP

- A. Start by adding in Pathbrite as an app into Canvas:
  - i. Please ensure that the external tool privacy settings are set to Public, rather than anonymous (default setting) like in the screen shot below:



- B. Enter in correct information from Pathbrite on install
  - i. Key
  - ii. Secret
  - iii. API URL:

## 2. ADD IN AN SSO LINK OR ASSIGNMENT MASHUP LINK

- A. At this point, you can either
  - i. Create integrated assignments. Please review the following video for steps to create an integrated assignment within Canvas, that will allow grade book pass back:

  - ii. Create an SSO link: Create the same app as above, but add in a custom parameter of: `custom_link_type=portfolio`
- B. Now, click through into either.

## 3. MAPPING NOW IN PROGRESS

Once it's set up correctly, you'll see messaging when linking over to Pathbrite stating (after creating an integrated assignment or sso link):

"We are in the process of mapping your LMS to a Pathbrite community. We will contact you when we've completed the setup. Please contact [support@pathbrite.com](mailto:support@pathbrite.com) if you have any questions."

This is our final step in the process to map the correct community on the Pathbrite end with your Canvas implementation and will only show up until we finish the mapping on our end.
