

## 1. ADD EXTERNAL TOOL

- A. Start by adding in Pathbrite as an external tool to Moodle (<http://d.pr/i/ap4w>):
  - i. Include the custom param of: tool\_consumer\_instance\_name=Moodle
- B. Enter in correct information from Pathbrite on install
  - i. Key
  - ii. Secret
  - iii. API URL: <https://api.pathbrite.com/service/lti/launch>

## 2. ADD IN AN SSO LINK OR ASSIGNMENT MASHUP LINK

- A. At this point, you can either
  - i. add in a Pathbrite integrated assignment link to Moodle: [https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=xQ\\_eyz6PXeE](https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=xQ_eyz6PXeE)
- B. Create an SSO link:  
<https://pathbrite.com/showcase/PP9-PMuPXG-Pd/integration-videos/item/PP9-PMuPXG-PduPXqN> - this uses the custom parameter of: link\_type=portfolio
- C. CNow, click through into either.

## 3. MAPPING NOW IN PROGRESS

Once it's set up correctly, you'll see messaging when linking over to Pathbrite stating (after creating an integrated assignment or sso link):

"We are in the process of mapping your LMS to a Pathbrite community. We will contact you when we've completed the setup. Please contact [support@pathbrite.com](mailto:support@pathbrite.com) if you have any questions."

This is our final step in the process to map the correct community on the Pathbrite end with your Moodle implementation and will only show up until we finish the mapping on our end.

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
